

Organisation and Development

Setting up and running a community group or voluntary organisation requires many skills. Some of these you may have others you will need to develop.

You can get help with developing your organisation from your Local Infrastructure Organisation (LIO) (ie Community Action Voluntary Action, Council for Voluntary Service).
